

Activity 7

“For Example?”

Goal: develop evidence by giving examples

Students sit in pairs.

The teacher gives a statement and asks the students to think about examples.

After each of the teacher’s statements the students put their heads together and think of an example.

After students give their answers the teacher says another statement.

For example:

- “Sometimes schools do not teach enough about what children need to know in later life, for example ...”
- “There are some things you cannot plan for, for example ...”
- “Sometimes you need to be patient, for example ...”
