

Activity 35

“Numbered Heads Together”– Review Quiz in Groups

Goals: review previous sessions / improve fair teamwork skills

Students are placed in groups, each group is given a character (“A”, “B” and so on) and each student is given a number (from 1 to the maximum number in each group).

The teacher poses a question and students “put their heads together” to figure out the answer.

The teacher asks several review questions, like for example:

What is the difference between a debate and a discussion?

What are the rules of a debate?

What makes a good debater?

What does A-R-E stand for?

What kind of counterargument can you make against the position: “Students should not wear school uniform?”

For the particular answer to one of the questions, the teacher calls a group and a number of a student from that specific group.
