

Activity 38

“Find Solutions!”

Goals: think creatively / enquire into change

Teacher breaks students up in pairs and gives each pair an argument. Students are asked to think about one (or better: two) possible solutions to the problem.

Teacher gives an examples of the task, like:

“Many people die because of smoking” (possible solutions: ban smoking or educate people about the danger of smoking)

Suggestions for topics which might be suitable for this exercise:

Animals are kept in zoos in cruel conditions /

People are starving in Africa /

The crime rate is rising /

Many kids behave badly in schools /

Food is too expensive /

Cities are overcrowded by cars
